Deployments and frequent moves can be a stressful and uncertain time for our nation's service members and their families. Many sacrifices are made by military personnel and their families to ensure our country is protected. As military personnel, you and your family can combine fitness and social opportunities to create a healthy mind, body, and spirit.

The Southeastern Indiana YMCA is proud to offer **two options** of Military Memberships for service men and women and their families:

1. Service member must be on **Title 10** orders with at least **six months** remaining as of the signature date on the application form and meet all criteria in one of the following categories:

<p>CATEGORY 1: ACTIVE DUTY *Independent Duty Personnel (IDP)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> I am assigned to a Service-designated Independent Duty Station that is not at or near a free or Service- provided fitness facility; AND<input type="checkbox"/> I require a single-person membership or my family resides with me and I require a family membership. Only one membership type (single or family) authorized. <p><i>* Category 1 includes National Guard and Reserve members on Title 10 IDP assignment.</i></p>
<p>CATEGORY 2: Unaccompanied Spouse/Family of ACTIVE DUTY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Sponsor is deployed or on "unaccompanied tour" orders that require the member to reside at an assigned duty location and restricts the spouse/family from accompanying the member; AND<input type="checkbox"/> Sponsor's family resides at a Service-designated independent duty station or in an area that is not at or near a free or Service-provided fitness facility.
<p>CATEGORY 3: Unaccompanied Spouse/Family of DEPLOYED GUARD and RESERVES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Sponsor is on deployment orders that require the member to reside at an assigned duty location that restricts the spouse/family from accompanying the member; AND<input type="checkbox"/> Sponsor's family resides at a Service-designated independent duty station or in an area that is not at or near a free or Service-provided fitness facility.
<p>CATEGORY 4: *Community Based Warrior Transition Unit / Warrior Care Unit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> My duty location is my house address.<input type="checkbox"/> My home address is not located at or near a free or Service-provided fitness facility.<input type="checkbox"/> I require a single-person membership or my family resides with me and I require a family membership. Only one membership type (single or family) authorized. <p><i>* Personnel on IDP assignment as support staff to a warrior transition/care unit must use Category 1 (IDP).</i></p> <p><i>Note: Exceptions to the established categories is a lengthy process and require strong justification. Submit "Waiver Request" along with the membership application for case-by-case consideration.</i></p>

2. Southeastern Indiana YMCA offers all military that does not qualify for the Title 10 Personnel a discounted joiners fee of \$25(a \$50 discount). This includes veterans joining the Y.

What Do I Need To Do To Be Accepted For The Military Outreach Initiative (MOI)?

1. View and print the link pages above or download to your computer
2. Service members are to determine their eligibility
3. Fill out the application and Command form
4. Submit paperwork to their unit POC or their MCAO directly.
5. Service members/families are required to maintain a minimum of 48 calendar day visits total for the entire 6 month. Attendance is one of the main requirements for renewal request and if attendance is not met, the renewal request maybe denied.
